

ORDINANCE NO. 165

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER ISLAND, FLORIDA, VACATING PART OF ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS, a Resolution was adopted on the 4th day of November, 1985, by the Town Commission of the Town of Jupiter Island, Florida, calling for a public hearing concerning the proposed vacation of part of a road right-of-way more particularly described as follows:

North 25 feet and South 25 feet of the right-of-way for Greenville Road between Beach Road and Gomez Road, Jupiter Island, Florida.

and declaring the intention of the Town Commission to so vacate;

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of February, 1986, such public hearing was held and no person or entity appeared to protest the vacation of said part of said road right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the property abutting that part of the road right-of-way to be vacated have consented to, or failed to contest, the vacation of same; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission believes it is in the best interests of the Town to vacate that part of the road right-of-way described above;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER ISLAND, FLORIDA:

Section 1. THAT that part of the road right-of-way described above is vacated and closed.

Section 2. THAT this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by law.

Section 3. THAT upon this Ordinance being finally adopted, a certified copy thereof shall be filed in the Martin County public records.
